1. Where is the green peafowl found?

The green peafowl are found in different habitats, such as tropical and subtropical forests, [savannas](#), [primary forests](#), [secondary forests](#), deciduous forests, evergreen forests, grasslands and shrublands.

2. Can green peafowl eat snakes?

Yes, green peafowl are among the few animals that eat venomous snakes.

3. According to their eating habits, into which group are peafowl classified?

Peafowl belong to the class of omnivorous animals, as they eat foods such as flower petals, seeds, grasses, insects, reptiles and small-sized amphibians.

4. What is the difference between the sound of green peafowl and blue peafowl?

In green peafowl, males produce an ear-piercing, ki-wao or a-wow sound, while females produce an ear-piercing aow-aa sound. In blue peafowl, males produce an ear-piercing may-yow sound, while females produce a range of less loud sounds.
