An English artist, <u>Joseph Grimaldi</u>, is known as the father of modern clowns. He made an enormous contribution to the clowning industry. Joseph Grimaldi first appeared on the stage in 1802 as a clown named 'Joey' at the <u>Sadler's Wells theater</u> in London. In modern-day circuses, a clown's face has been painted with different colors. Joseph Grimaldi was the first clown to appear with colorful faces.
