

Interesting flower facts (About Types of lilies)

1. Did you know the common types of lilies?

The lily flower divided into different types, including Asiatic lilies, Oriental lilies, Trumpet lilies, Easter lilies, Turk's cap lilies, and Tiger lilies are the types of lily commonly found around the world.

a) Asiatic lilies

Asiatic lilies comes in a distinct range of colors, such as yellow, orange, pink, red, and white. "Lilium Asiatic hybrids" is the scientific name for Asiatic lilies and can be easily grown. They produce abundant flowers frequently. Asiatic hybrids are a type of lily flower obtained from various species of lilies found in Asia. They have either up-facing or out-facing flowers and can have flat or trumpet shapes. These are commonly utilized in bouquets.

b) Oriental lilies:

Oriental lilies are big-sized flowers and have a sweet and strong fragrance. These flowers are frequently used in flower arrangements and in bouquets. The native lands for Oriental lilies are Korea and Japan. The Stargazer lily is one of the most popular varieties of this type of lily. The Stargazer lily is popular due to its large size and fragrant flowers, which face upward. In 1974, breeder Leslie Wood-riff developed the Stargazer lily in California.

c) Trumpet lilies:

Trumpet Lily flowers are large and fragrant. These trumpet-shaped flowers are often found in gardens. They can be easily grown in neutral and well drained soil. They come in distinct range of colors, such as white, yellow, pink, and apricot. They can reach a height of 3-8 feet. The Trumpet lily species are native to China.

d) Easter lilies:

Easter lily have the scientific name Lilium longiflorum. they are trumpet shaped, and appear in white. Easter lilies are native to japan.

e) Turk's cap lily:

Turk's cap lily is named for its petals' similarity to a Turkish turban. The Turk's cap lily has the scientific name Lilium superbum. They are found in North America and can reach a height of 3-7 feet. They appear as orange-yellow or reddish-orange in color. They can grow well in acidic and moist soil.

f) Tiger lily

This type of lily flower shows similarities to tiger color with a dark spot on the flower. The dark spot on the lily flower resembles strips on a tiger's body. Lilium lancifolium is the scientific name of the well-known tiger lily. They can reach a height of 2-5 feet and native to East Asia.

g) Madonna lily:

The scientific name of Madonna's lily is Lilium candidum. They have medicinal properties and have historically been used in therapy. They can be applied to the skin for inflammation and burn treatment. Its fragrance has induced sleep and made the mind calm. They can grow well in moist and acidic soil and are native to the Balkan and middle east regions.
